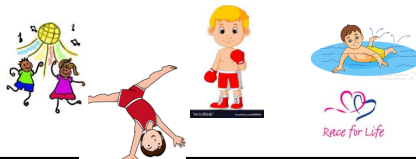
A Right Royal Celebration!
